The 2022 season opens May 7th, with a departure of Pearl's **7-Night Maine Coast & Canadian Harbors** cruise, roundtrip from Portland, ME; followed by the Line's longest itinerary, a **15-Night Canadian Maritimes & St. Lawrence Seaway** cruise, from Portland, ME to Toronto, Canada.
